PER CURIAM:

This case is before us on its merits for the second time. In *United States v. Adams*, ACM 36104 (A.F. Ct. Crim. App. 31 Oct 2005) (unpub. op.), this Court affirmed the appellant's conviction and sentence. In a summary disposition on appeal, in light of their decision in *United States v. Lane*, 64 M.J. 1 (C.A.A.F. 2006), our superior court set aside our decision and returned the case for a new review under Article 66(c), UCMJ, 10 U.S.C. § 866(c). *United States v. Adams*, 64 M.J. 189, 189-90 (C.A.A.F. 2006).

Upon further review, the approved findings and sentence are correct in law and fact, and no error prejudicial to the substantial rights of the appellant occurred. Article 66(c), UCMJ, 10

U.S.C. § 866(c); *United States v. Reed*, 54 M.J. 37, 41 (C.A.A.F. 2000). Accordingly, the approved findings and sentence are

AFFIRMED.
