* The Court notes the Court-Martial Order (CMO), dated 6 October 2009, fails to include the language “on divers occasions” in Specifications 1 and 3 of the Charge. Additionally, the Charge should not be identified as Charge I. The Court orders the promulgation of a corrected CMO.

Accordingly, the approved findings and sentence are

AFFIRMED.
