We note that the court-martial order is erroneously listed as a general court-martial order rather than as a special court-martial order. Preparation of a corrected court-martial order, properly reflecting the court-martial as a special court-martial is hereby directed. *See United States v. Smith*, 30 M.J. 1022, 1028 (A.F.C.M.R. 1990).

The approved findings and sentence are correct in law and fact, and no error prejudicial to the substantial rights of the appellant occurred. Article 66(c), UCMJ, 10 U.S.C. § 866(c); *United States v. Reed*, 54 M.J. 37, 41 (C.A.A.F. 2000).
