**PER CURIAM:**

This case is before our Court for further review because the original action was set aside. *United States v. James*, ACM S35951 (A.F. Ct. Crim. App. 29 Aug 2005) (unpub. op.). This Court returned the case to The Judge Advocate General for remand to the convening authority for new post-trial processing. On 9 December 2005, the case was forwarded to our Court for review under Article 66, UCMJ, 10 U.S.C. § 866.

The appellant submitted the record and a new action for further review on its merits. Our review discloses no substantive errors.
