PER CURIAM:

The approved findings and sentence are correct in law and fact, and no error prejudicial to the substantial rights of the appellant occurred. Article 66(c), UCMJ, 10 U.S.C. § 866(c); *United States v. Reed*, 54 M.J. 37, 41 (C.A.A.F. 2000). Further, we order the promulgation of a corrected Court-Martial Order reflecting that the convening authority took action on 13 February 2008 and that the plea to Charge II was Guilty.\*
