PER CURIAM:

The approved findings and sentence are correct in law and fact, and no error prejudicial to the substantial rights of the appellant occurred.* Article 66(c), UCMJ, 10 U.S.C. § 866(c); *United States v. Reed*, 54 M.J. 37, 41 (C.A.A.F. 2000).

* The Court notes the Court-Martial Order (CMO), dated 7 May 2008, incorrectly states the appellant pled "Guilty" to Charge II as a violation of Article 130, UCMJ, 10 U.S.C. § 930. The appellant actually pled "Not Guilty" to the Article 130, UCMJ, offense, but "Guilty" to the lesser included offense of "Unlawful Entry" under Article 134, UCMJ, 10 U.S.C. § 934. The Court orders the promulgation of a corrected CMO.

Accordingly, the approved findings and sentence are

AFFIRMED.
