\* The Court notes that the Court-Martial Order (CMO), dated 12 February 2013 incorrectly states in Specification 1 of Charge II "...*General Order Prohibiting the Use Prohibiting and Possessing of Salvia, Spice, and Bath Salts...*", whereas it should state "...*General Order Prohibiting the Use and Possession of Salvia, Spice, and Bath Salts...*". The Court orders the promulgation of a corrected CMO.

Accordingly, the approved findings and sentence are AFFIRMED.
