PER CURIAM:

The approved findings and sentence are correct in law and fact, and no error prejudicial to the substantial rights of the appellant occurred. Article 66(c), UCMJ, 10 U.S.C. § 866(c); *United States v. Reed*, 54 M.J. 37, 41 (C.A.A.F. 2000). We note, however, that the promulgating order erroneously reflects adjudged forfeitures of “\$767.00 for three months,” omitting the words “pay per month.” This is an administrative error that should be corrected to accurately reflect the

actual sentence imposed by the court members. Accordingly, the approved findings and sentence are

AFFIRMED.
