¹ The Court notes that the General Court-Martial Order (GCMO), dated 3 May 2010 incorrectly includes Specification 7 of Additional Charge I. Specification 7 was dismissed by the convening authority on 14 August 2009, prior to the appellant's arraignment on 27 August 2009. Additionally, Article 128 cited in Additional Charge III should be changed to Article 134. The Court orders the promulgation of a corrected GCMO.

Accordingly, the approved findings and sentence are

AFFIRMED.
