On 16 February 2011, appellant's counsel filed a third Motion for Expedited Review and also moved to modify the relief requested in appellant's Assignment of Errors. Appellant government counsel filed an opposition to the motion on 17 February 2011. Contrary to appellate defense counsel's assertion that this Court granted his first Motion for Expedited Review, this Court merely noted in that Order the "appellant's case will be reviewed without unnecessary delay upon receipt of the government's reply." Even if this could somehow be construed by appellant as granting an expedited review, no date certain or time period was specified by this Court for completion of its review.

Appellant's second Motion for Expedited Review was denied by this Court on 1 February 2011 as being moot. As appellant's case is already under review by this Court, Appellant's third Motion for Expedited Review is likewise moot.

Accordingly, it is by the Court on this 3rd day of March, 2011.

**ORDERED:**

The appellant's third Motion for Expedited Review is **DENIED**.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:**

Appellant's Motion to Modify the relief requested in her Assignment of Errors is **GRANTED.**
