PER CURIAM:

We have examined the record of trial, the assignment of error raised pursuant to *United States v. Grostefon*, 12 M.J. 431 (C.M.A. 1982), and the government's reply thereto. We hold that the sentence adjudged and approved is not inappropriately severe. See *United States v. Healy*, 26 M.J. 394, 395 (C.M.A. 1988).

The approved findings and sentence are correct in law and fact, and no error prejudicial to the substantial rights of the appellant occurred. Article 66(c), UCMJ, 10 U.S.C. § 866(c); *United States v. Reed*, 54 M.J. 37, 41 (C.A.A.F. 2000). Accordingly, the approved findings and sentence are
