PER CURIAM:

The approved findings and sentence are correct in law and fact, and no error prejudicial to the substantial rights of the appellant occurred.* Article 66(c), UCMJ, 10 U.S.C. § 866(c); *United States v. Reed*, 54 M.J. 37, 41 (C.A.A.F. 2000).

* Although not affecting the legal sufficiency of the findings or sentence, the court-martial order erroneously includes excepting language in the plea and finding of the Charge. The excepting language should only be included in the Specification of the Charge. The appellant plead guilty to and was found guilty of the Charge. We order the promulgation of a corrected court-martial order.

Accordingly, the approved findings and sentence are

AFFIRMED.
