PER CURIAM:

* The Court notes the Court-Martial Order (CMO), dated 4 April 2008, incorrectly spelled the appellant's first name as NATHNIEL, the correct spelling is NATHANIEL. The Court further notes the CMO incorrectly identifies the military judge as BRYAN W. WATSON, the correct spelling is BRYAN D. WATSON. The Court orders the promulgation of a corrected CMO.
