ABOUT AFCCA OPINIONS

Opinions of the Court are issued by individual Court panels unless, at the suggestion of appellate counsel or on the Court's own initiative, the case is considered *en banc* (by the Court as a whole). An opinion may be issued *per curiam* (without identifying the individual judge who authored the opinion) or under the name of the author judge. It is common for panels to release shorter opinions *per curiam*. All opinions of the Court are issued in writing, but not all opinions are “published.” Published opinions are printed in the Military Justice Reporter series. Published and many unpublished opinions are included in the Lexis-Nexis and Westlaw databases and are posted to the AFCCA website. Most short, *per curiam* opinions issued prior to 2004 are not published or posted electronically, but are available upon request from the Clerk of Court.
