## TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE UNITED STATES AIR FORCE COURT OF CRIMINAL APPEALS:

Pursuant to Rule 23.3(m) of this Honorable Court's Rules of Practice and Procedure, Appellant hereby moves for an enlargement of time to file an Assignment of Errors (AOE). Appellant requests an enlargement for a period of 30 days, which will end on 19 October 2020. The record of trial was received by this division on 22 April 2020. From the date the record of trial was received to the present date, 144 days have elapsed. On the date requested, 180 days will have elapsed. This motion was due on 12 September 2020, and as such is being filed out of time, pursuant to Rule 23.3.(m)(7).

Per Rule 23.3(m), Appellant provides the following information in support of this request:

On 31 January 2020, Appellant was tried before a special court-martial d of a military judge alone at Shaw Air Force Base, South Carolina. In ce with his pleas, Appellant was found guilty of one charge and three

specifications of wrongful use of controlled substances, in violation of Article 112a,

UCMJ, 10 U.S.C. § 912a; and one charge and two specification of conduct prejudicial

to good order and discipline in the armed forces, in violation of Article 134, UCMJ, 10

U.S.C. § 934. R. at Vol. 3, Entry of Judgment.

Appellant was sentenced to confinement for a total of 210 days and a bad

conduct discharge. *Id.* The convening authority approved the sentence as adjudged.

*Id.* Appellant is not in confinement.

There were no motions argued. The record of trial has 3 volumes and the trial

transcript has 111 pages. There are 7 prosecution exhibits, 1 defense exhibit, and 14

appellate exhibits.

Counsel is an Individual Mobilization Augmentee (Category B) Reservist and

is employed full time as an Assistant United States Attorney in the District of South

Dakota. Counsel has reviewed the record and begun researching the identified

issues, but further time is necessary in light of the identified issues so that Appellant

may have the benefit of appellate counsel

**Accordingly**, counsel requests that this Honorable Court grant this motion.
