On 11 February 2022, your case, No. ACM S32721, was docketed with this court for review under its authority pursuant to Article 66, Uniformed Code of Military Justice (UCMJ), 10 U.S.C. § 866. As indicated in the record of trial, an Air Force (AF) Form 304, *Request for Appellate Defense Counsel*, was signed by you on 9 December 2021 and again on 19 January 2022, in which you elected not to have an appellate defense counsel represent you. Therefore, this notice is to inform you that your case is now before this court for appellate review.

Per this court's Rules of Practice and Procedure, Rule 18(d), you have 60 days from the date of this letter to file a brief to this court identifying any assignments of error with your case, if you elect to do so. The Government will then have 30 days to file an answer in response to any assignments of error filed by you. You will then have seven days to file a reply to the Government's answer.
