On 25 July 2022, your case, ACM No. 40309, was docketed with this court for review under its authority pursuant to Article 66, Uniformed Code of Military Justice (UCMJ), 10 U.S.C. § 66. As indicated in the record of trial, on Air Force (AF) Forms 304, dated 3 May 2022 and 23 May 2022, you elected not to have an Appellate Defense Counsel represent you. Therefore, this notice is to inform you that your case is now before this court for appellate review.

Per the court's Rules of Practice and Procedure, Rule 18(d), you have 60 days from the date of receipt of this letter to file a brief to identify any assignments of error with your case, if any. The Government will then have 30 days to file an answer in response to any assignments of error filed by you. You will then have 7 days to file a reply to the Government's answer.
