Pursuant to Rule 23.3(m)(1), (3)-(4) of this Honorable Court’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, Appellant hereby moves for an enlargement of time to file Assignments of Error. Appellant requests an enlargement for a period of 30 days, which will end on **12 October 2025**. The record of trial was docketed with this Court on 15 May 2025. From the date of docketing to the present date, 110 days have elapsed. On the date requested, 150 days will have elapsed.

On 12 March 2025, Appellant was tried by a special court-martial composed of a military judge alone at Seymour Johnson Air Force Base, North Carolina. Trial Tr. at 1, 14. Appellant was found guilty, consistent with his pleas, of one charge and one specification of violation of a lawful general order in violation of Article 92, UCMJ, 10 U.S.C. § 892, and one charge and one specification of wrongful use of a controlled substance in violation of Article 112a, UCMJ, 10 U.S.C. § 912a. Trial Tr. at 15, 57, 81; Electronic Record of Trial (eROT) Vol 1, *Entry of Judgment* (Mar. 27, 2025).

The military judge sentenced Appellant to reduction in pay grade to E-1 and a bad conduct discharge. Trial Tr. at 92; eROT Vol 1, *Entry of Judgment* (Mar. 27, 2025). The convening

authority took no action on the findings or the sentence. eROT Vol 1, *Convening Authority Decision on Action* (Mar. 18, 2025).

The trial transcript is 93 pages long. The electronic record of trial contains four Prosecution Exhibits and three Appellate Exhibits. Appellant is not currently confined.

Appellant has been advised of his right to a timely appeal. Appellant has not been provided an update of the status of counsel's progress on his case. Appellant has not been advised of this request for an enlargement of time. Appellant has neither expressed agreement nor disagreement with this request for an enlargement of time.

Through no fault of Appellant, undersigned counsel has been unable to complete their review of Appellant's case. An enlargement of time is necessary to allow counsel to fully review Appellant's case and advise him regarding potential errors.

**WHEREFORE**, Appellant requests that this Court grant the requested enlargement of time for good cause shown.

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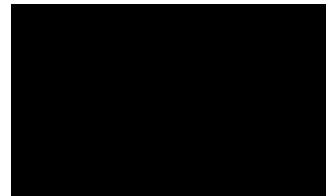

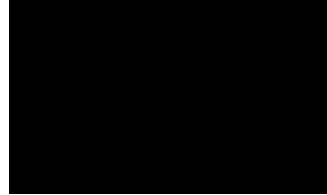

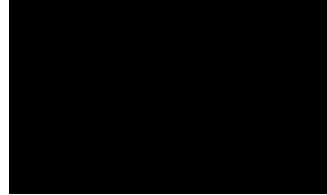
