The record of trial in the above-styled case was returned to this court on 10 January 2025 by the Military Appellate Records Branch (JAJM) for re-docketing with the court.



On 6 December 2024, this court remanded Appellant’s case to the Chief Trial Judge, Air Force Trial Judiciary, to correct the record under Rule of Courts-Martial 1112(d) to include in Appellant’s record of trial the missing audio recording of Appellant’s 26 June 2023 arraignment. The record of trial was to be returned to the court not later than 9 January 2025 for completion of this court’s review under Article 66, UCMJ.

The military judge complied with this court’s 6 December 2024 order by returning the record of trial with the audio recording of Appellant’s 26 June 2023 arraignment. The court re-docketed Appellant’s case on 15 January 2025.
