On 27 March 2025, your case (ACM S32818) was docketed with this court for review under its authority pursuant to Article 66, Uniformed Code of Military Justice (UCMJ), 10 U.S.C. § 866. As indicated in the record of trial, an Air Force (AF) Form 304, Request for Appellate Defense Counsel, was signed by you on 15 August 2024 and again on 31 March 2025, in which you elected not to have an appellate defense counsel represent you. Therefore, this notice is to inform you that your case is now before this court for appellate review.

Per Rule 18(d) of the Joint Rules of Appellate Procedure for Courts of Criminal Appeals, you have 60 days from the date of this letter to file a brief identifying any assignments of error you wish the Court to consider, if you elect to do so. The Government will then have 30 days to file an answer in response to any assignments of error filed by you. You will then have seven days to file a reply to the Government's answer.

Accordingly, it is by the court on this 16th day of May, 2025,


ORDERED:
